The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.179 dated 11.07.2013 under Sections 498 A/406 IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala at the instance of respondent No.2-wife, Anjana on the basis of compromise.

Parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Barnala and get their statements recorded. A report has been received that parties have voluntarily entered into a compromise.

Following the judgment in ***Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052***, petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to compliance of the conditions of the compromise.

It is ordered that the case property taken into possession during investigation would be released to the complainant in case she moves an application before the Investigating Officer.

Another condition is imposed that the petitioners will not in any manner harass or threaten the complainant as the parties appeared to be residing in the close vicinity.
