RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No. 75 dated 18.06.2014, under Sections 395 IPC (Section 411 IPC was subsequently added vide DDR No.12, dated 19.06.2014) registered at Police Station, Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on 17.06.2014 at about 9.00 pm, when the complainant going to his house with one bag carrying Rs.3,50,000/- in cash and some documents, four persons namely Anuj Kumar @ Noji, Sarabjit Singh @ Sabi, Amandeep Singh and Happy came and focibly snatched the said bag and run away in the vehicle bearing registration No.PB01A-1337. The present petitioner was arrested on 01.08.2014. There are specific allegations that accused persons namely Amandeep Singh, Anuj Kumar, Sarabjit Singh, Harpreet Singh and Parwinder Singh had forcibly snatched the bag from the complainant-Surinder Singh.

Counsel for the State has opposed the bail application of the petitioner on the ground that the after presentation of challan, charges have been framed and thereafter prosecution witnesses are to be examined. Petitioner was given a share of Rs.15,000/- from the said Rs.3,50,000/- which has been spent by her.

Counsel for the petitioner stated that there is no similar complaint pending against the present petitioner.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that the trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail subject to furnishing bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.
