FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Since the petitioner-Lakhpat Singh was declared as proclaimed offender in a criminal complaint filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, and on account of his own conduct of absconding from law, a case under Section 174-A IPC was registered against him. The contentions of the petitioner's counsel that the matter stands compromised between the parties would have no bearing on the case so registered under Section 174-A IPC which is by way FIR No.541 dated 28.9.2010 Police Station Gurgaon City as the cause of action and the allegations are materially different and have no bearing with the compromise so effected between the parties.

At this stage learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement that he wishes to withdraw the present petition reserving his right to rake up all these issues in

appropriate proceedings before the Courts below.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty
aforesaid.
