Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.356 dated 20.12.2013 under Sections 307 and 452 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the complainant contends that during

pendency of the present petition, the offence under Section 307 IPC has been deleted by learned Additional Sessions Judge and the matter has been sent for trial before learned Judicial Magistrate.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition and wishes to approach the Sessions Court for grant of bail qua the remaining offence.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Sessions Court for the relief of anticipatory bail.
