Quashing of the FIR No.35 dated 19.02.2014 under Sections 354, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Manda, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise, is being sought.

The FIR was registered on a statement made by Anjali Duggal-respondent No.2/complainant alleging that the petitioner-Sunil Kumar @ Nana used to harass her and with the intervention of the respectables of the village, he apologized. Thereafter, on 19.02.2014, when she was coming back on her activa to her house from college then the petitioner on his motorcycle came behind her and by taking his motorcycle ahead of her activa started giving abuses as well as forcing her to sit on the rear seat of his motorcycle. He was demanding her mobile number. He snatched her school bag and when

she raised a noise, he ran away from the spot. In this background, the FIR was registered.

During the pendency of the trial, the matter has now been compromised by the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 01.09.2014, status report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar and the statements of the parties have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter and the complainant has no objection if the present FIR is quashed.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.35 dated 19.02.2014 under Sections 354, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Rama Manda, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioner.
