AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.34 dated 16.05.2015 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Bhadson, District Patiala.

Learned Addional Advocate General on instructions from ASI Maggar Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 22.07.2015 is made absolute.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
