Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.50 dated 14.5.2015 registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jagbir Singh, Police Station City Dhuri, submits that in compliance of the order dated 3.8.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation. However, learned counsel for the complainant submits that many dowry articles are yet to be recovered from the petitioner.

Be that as it may, leaving the scope of claim of the complainant open, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 3.8.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
