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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Present petition is on behalf of the husband for seeking anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.PC in FIR No.30 dated 03.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has become infructuous as his client has since been arrested.

Learned Counsel for the complainant points out that on the previous date of hearing i.e. on 8.9.2015 the parties were summoned in Court, the complainant-wife had come present whereas the petitioner-husband had remained absent thereby the Court was constrained to adjourn

the case for today. For such adjournment and presence of the wife, the Court had directed a payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, the said cost to date has not been paid. Thus, the prayer is for a direction to the petitioner-accused for payment of the said costs of Rs.10,000/- to the complainant-wife.

In view of the above, present petition is hereby dismissed as infructuous.

However, It is directed that the petitioner-accused shall pay the aforesaid outstanding costs of Rs.10,000/- to the complainant-wife. The prosecution shall ensure the payment of such costs. Copy of this order shall be placed on the file of the learned trial Court.
