Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.42 dated 27.06.2015 under Sections 324, 323, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 406 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station City Mansa, District Mansa.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned counsel for the complainant are ad idem that during pendency of the present petition, parties have arrived at an amicable settlement by way of compromise and on the basis thereof, petitioners have filed CRM-M-31529-2015 (Dharampal and another Vs.
