This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Tarsem Singh Kaler seeking issuance of direction to respondents to conduct fair and impartial investigation in the death case of father of the petitioner namely Late Sh. Darshan Singh and to call status report of investigation conducted. However, learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied, if his petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of his representation (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 2 only, at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

It has further been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that representation dated February 18, 2015 (Annexure P-2) was moved to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) but despite that fact no action has been taken by the official respondent(s) so far.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana (Rural) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated February 18, 2015 (Annexure P-2) and in case, some substance is found, take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
