By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case, FIR No. 117 dated 16.05.2014, registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel contends that a compromise has been arrived at between the parties. The petitioner has repaid the entire amount allegedly sought to be recovered from him. In pursuance of the order dated 30.01.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
