JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 86 dated 01.05.2012 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, on the basis of compromise along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at the compromise without any pressure. The same seems to be genuine. Even otherwise, matter involved in these proceedings is personal in nature,

which has been amicably put at rest.

3. So, in view of circumstances narrated above as well as the observations made in case reported as **Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for the benefit of the parties and would certainly bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition is allowed and FIR No. 86 dated 01.05.2012 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 120-B and 506 IPC registered at Police Station, Sadar Ferozepur, District Ferozepur and all other subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom stand quashed qua the petitioners.
