Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar for reviving the criminal complaint No. 5/20.02.2007 titled as 'Kulwinder Singh vs. Manmeet Kaur' and quashing of order dated 06.12.2008 passed by learned JMIC, Amritsar discharging the accused on the basis of order dated 07.11.2008 passed by Hon'ble High Court, without issuing notice and hearing the complainant, and further directing the learned JMIC to conduct the trial of the said complaint in an expeditious manner and further direction to respondent No.3 to consider and take appropriate action on the applications {Annexure P-9 (Colly)}.

2. Notice of motion to official respondents, only at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Ankur Jain, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case applications/reminders (Annexure P-9) moved by petitioner are dealt with and dispose of within a stipulated period.

5. Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Amritsar to enquire into the allegations unfolded by the petitioner in applications/reminders (Annexure P-9) and in case any substance is found therein, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
