Parteek Jain and Summaiya @ Siya, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major and seek protection as they apprehend danger from respondents No. 4 and 5. Marriage certificate has not been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner No. 2 has converted to Hindu. He has placed on record the affidavit sworn by petitioner No. 2 as Annexure P-3.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to approach respondent No. 2 and present their representation. On doing so, respondent No. 2 would be obligated to look into the grievance and take steps he deems fit strictly in accordance with law. This order shall not be construed to be conferring legitimacy or authenticity to the factum of marriage having been performed as Court is clearly deprived of any means to determine the facts.
