Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.133 dated 3.5.2015, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 506 IPC (subsequently Section 3 of the Scheduled Caste & Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocity) Act, 1988 and Section 354-A IPC were added on 1.7.2015), registered at Police Station Madlauda, District Panipat.

In terms of order dated 21.9.2015, the Superintendent of Police, Panipat has filed the status report dated 17.11.2015. As per

report, the investigation in the case has been completed and final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared and the same is to be submitted in the Court of Illaqa Magistrate in the due course. The report further suggests that the investigating authority did not find any evidence regarding threat to the complainant from accused persons in the present FIR.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 22.7.2015 are made absolute.
