The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., 1973, for the safeguard of the fundamental rights under Article 21 of the Constitution of India, seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and other family members of petitioner No.1.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Deepak Garg, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances of petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated 20.07.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
