Prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.61 dated 19.5.2015 under Sections 406,420,120-B IPC read with Section 24 of Emigration Act, 1983 registered with P.S Division No.3, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points that the husband of the petitioner was arrested and released on regular bail.

Learned state counsel states that the petitioner has joined investigation. She has accepted that the allegations are mainly against the husband of the petitioner and that the only allegation against the petitioner is that she had taken some money.

In view of the above, order dated 23.7.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
