Petitioner seeks directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to inquire into the complaint made by him in respect of damage to his crop and dismantling of boundary wall and also efforts to take forcible possession of his land. Seeing the pathetic attitude of the official respondents, petitioner has ventured to file the present petition seeking direction for protection of his life and property from being invaded by private respondent No.5.

Precisely in the aforesaid context, a detailed representation dated 18.6.2014 (Annexure P-4) is pending consideration before respondent No.3.

This Court feels just and appropriate to direct respondent No.3 to look into the allegations made by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in safeguarding his interest in accordance with

law within a period of two months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of.
