MAHESH GROVER, J

The petitioner has impugned the order dated 19.4.2012 (Annexure P-2) by which a publication has been effected declaring him a Proclaimed Offender pursuant to Section 82 Cr.P.C. The case against the petitioner is on the basis of a complaint preferred by his estranged wife under Sections 352, 406, 498, 506, 34 IPC.

During the course of the proceedings the petitioner has paid the maintenance amount to the complainant by way of demand drafts. A prayer has also been made that petitioner is willing to submit himself to the process of law by appearing before learned Trial Court without any future default.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has settled the equities by making the payment to the complainant – wife and has also undertaken to appear before the Trial Court without any further default, I am of the view that the ends of justice would be served if the impugned order is stayed in so far as arrest of the petitioner is concerned. Ordered accordingly.

Petitioner is directed to submit himself before the Trial Court within a

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period of one month from today.

If he does so then his arrest shall remain stayed subject to his furnishing an undertaking before the Trial Court to the following effect:-

- i) that he will associate himself with the trial.
- ii) That he will abide by all the conditions imposed by the Trial Court.

Trial Court shall accept his bail bonds.

Since the petitioner has bound himself to a surrender the impugned order is set aside.

Disposed of.
