These are the petitions under Section 439
Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.246 dated 18.10.2014
under Sections 420,392,467,468,471,472 IPC and Sections
25,54,59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station, City Faridkot.

The allegations against the petitioners Ranjit
Singh @ Dupla and Rajesh Kumar Gupta in these regular bail

applications are that they along with their co-accused were instrumental in illegal sale of firearms and that the present case against the petitioners was registered on the basis of secret information.

The contentions of both the counsel for the petitioners that nothing has been recovered from the petitioners inspite of interrogation and that petitioner Rajesh Kumar Gupta is not named in the FIR and that there is no evidence regarding their involvement in the commission of offences for which the have been booked are conceded to at bar by the learned State counsel who states that till date nothing is coming forth to connect the petitioners with the crime.

In view thereof and keeping in view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioners be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
