**SABINA, J**

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.344 dated 10.07.2015, under Sections 147, 148, 452, 323, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' for short) (Sections 324, 325, 354-D IPC and Section 12 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 added later on), registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridabad, District Faridabad.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 23.07.2015:-

*"Heard.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are neighbours of complainant as both parties are living in adjoining house and an altercation had taken place over the parking for the shop of petitioners in their house where they are carrying garments business. The injuries attributed to both the petitioners are simple in nature.*

*Notice of motion for 05.10.2015.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the police and join investigation. In*

*the event of their arrest being required, they shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to them."*

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Satya Narain has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 23.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
