The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate protection as regards life and liberty and property of the petitioner.

The allegations have been made as regards the petitioner and his family members being harassed and threatened at the hands of respondent No.5. An additional prayer has also been made in the petition for directing respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station Shambhu, Patiala not to interfere in the peaceful possession of the petitioner with regard to the property i.e. land measuring 300 square yards situated at Chattar Nagar, Tehsil Rajpura, District Patiala.

During the course of arguments, it stands conceded that the present petitioner has already instituted a suit for permanent injunction against Gurdev Singh as also Balbir Singh (present respondent No.5) and the same is pending before the Court of Additional Civil Judge, Rajpura. It is also the conceded position of fact that the petitioner has already moved an application before the Human Rights Commission Chandigarh as regards

the grievance raised in the present petition and the Commission in turn is seized of the matter and the matter is now marked for inquiry to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ghanaur.

In the light of such facts, there would be no basis for issuance of any directions in the present petition.

Petition is accordingly, disposed of.
