Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No.105 dated 27.06.2015, registered at Police Station Sector-3, Chandigarh, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is widow having two minor children. No forgery has been

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committed by the petitioner. The petitioner is 58 years old lady and she has been behind bars since 14.03.2013. The matter is still at the stage of investigation and it will take time.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
