The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 36 dated 19.2.2015 under Sections 382, 379-B, 411, 34 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

F.I.R was registered on the complaint of Manbir Singh, who stated himself to be working as a driver with Elee Ess Travel, Haibowal, Ludhiana. Allegations pertain to 18.2.2015 and the vehicle in question i.e. Chevrolet Enjoy being driven by the complainant from Ludhiana to Jalandhar was taken away on knife point by certain occupants and even a mobile make Samsung was snatched.

It has gone uncontroverted that the car as also the mobile of the complainant have been recovered from the co-accused Joginder Pal. The present petitioner has been sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused Joginder Pal and it has been stated that recovery of a knife has been effected from him.

Petitioner has been in custody since 18.3.2015.

Investigation in the case has already been completed and challan has been presented. Offences are triable by a court of Magistrate.

In the totality of the circumstances noticed herein above and without making any observations on the merits of the case, prayer is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.

Disposed of.
