Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.254 dated 08.05.2015, under Sections 148/149/307/332/353/186/120B/427 IPC, Section 24/54/59 of Arms Act 1959 and under Section 13/3/67 of Gambling Act, P.S. Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Allegations are that on secret information raid was conducted on the house of one Pappu. Fifteen persons were found gambling and playing *satta* in the context of on going IPL match between Delhi and Kolkata. Nine accused including petitioner were arrested on the spot, remaining six succeeded in fleeing from there.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar states that firing from country-made pistol is not attributed to petitioner. Petitioner along with others was involved in pelting of stones, thereby causing injuries to Police party.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner there is no specific part attributed to petitioner. House did not belong to him. Ingredients of offence under Gambling Act are not attracted to the present case.

Petitioner is in custody since 08.05.2015. Challan has already been presented.

In view of the above, without embarking upon merits of the case at this stage, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Palwal.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
