Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of concession of bail in FIR No.140 dated 13.06.2013, under Sections 409, 418, 420, 120-B, 467, 468 and 471 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Following order was passed by this Court vide order dated 18.08.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the amount involved in respect of petitioner is about ₹1,10,000/-.

As per medical report of Medical Officer, District Jail, Karnal, handed over by learned State counsel on the previous date, the petitioner has the history of

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Cardiac Disease and is being treated for the said disease. The petitioner was also sent to PGIMS, Rohtak for treatment.

List on 04.09.2015, for arguments.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

To be listed along with CRM-M-25424-2015.”

Heard.

Admittedly, so far as petitioner is concerned, the amount involved is about Rs.1,10,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that Rs.1,70,000/- was lying in the saving account of the petitioner with the complainant Bank. As per the report of the Medical Officer, District Jail, Karnal, petitioner is suffering from unstable Cardiac condition and as per his old record is suffering from Several Diastolic Dysfunction (Grade-III) with Several Left Systolic Dysfunction.

Keeping in view the medical condition of the petitioner as well as the facts and circumstances of the case, so far as the petitioner is concerned, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail.

Petitioner is on interim bail in terms of the order

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dated 18.08.2015.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners
by this Court vide order dated 18.08.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
