They have already moved application dated 21.01.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, for protecting their life and liberty.

In pursuance of notice of motion, respondent Nos.1 to 3 have filed reply in Court today which is taken on record. In para 4 of

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reply, it is mentioned that petitioner No.1 made a statement by way of affidavit (Annexure R-1/T) before the police that she does not require any police protection.
