Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No. 07, dated 17.04.2015, registered at Police Station Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that

investigation has been completed and the petitioner has been behind bars since 06.06.2015. The learned counsel further contends that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Pathankot.
