Instant petition has been moved by Netar Pal, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") seeking regular bail, in case FIR No. 55, dated 29.04.2014, under Sections 420, 409, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. The undisputed fact is that three cheques amounting to ₹3,19,000/-, ₹3,74,000/- and ₹3,16,700/- (total ₹10,09,700/-) has been issued by the Gram Panchayat in the name of petitioner instead of Khetarpal Cement Store. On the next day when it was came to the notice of Gram Panchayat, entire amount was withdrawn and then handed over to Madan Lal, Panchayat Secretary but he kept the said

amount up-to 28/30.09.2013 and, thereafter deposited the same in the account of Gram Panchayat, Bagpat of Punjab National Bank Chhachrauli. There is no other role attributed to the petitioner. His name also does not figure in the FIR. Petitioner is cooling his heels behind the bars since the date of his arrest i.e. July 01, 2015.

3. Taking into consideration all the aforesaid aspect of this case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, petition is allowed and petitioner- Netar Pal is ordered to be released on bail, during the pendency of trial, at the satisfaction of trial court/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.
