This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No. 4 and 5, father and mother of petitioner No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1-Rekha is 22.6.1980 as per copy of Aadhaar Card (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2-Arjun Singh is 24.3.1990 as per copy of Voter Card (Annexure P-2). They allegedly got married on 1.07.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation to be made by the petitioners to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, but without expressing any opinion on the validity of

marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the representation, if any, made by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
