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The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No. 125 dated 20.06.2014 registered at Police Station Alewa, District Jind under Sections 307/186/399/402 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners were arrested on 20.06.2015 and all the witnesses are police officials and only 6 witnesses have been examined out of 12 witnesses and charge was framed way back in September 2014 and the trial is taking long time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial will take long time to conclude and the petitioners are in custody since 20.06.2014, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court with a rider that the petitioners would not indulge any such activity. The prosecution would be free to approach the Court for cancellation of bail, if they do.
