Report dated 17.03.2015 sent by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-Cum-CJM Panchkula has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Pankaj Atwal and Mam Raj as well as of complainant Pravin Kaundal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the dispute between the parties is purely regarding business and which has been settled now by way of compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.466 dated 7.12.2012 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station, Sector 5

Panchkula and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
