Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 112, dated 30.06.2014, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bahav Wala, District Fazilka.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner that he is involved in a case where 2 kgs. of opium has been recovered from one of the accused. In such cases, custodial interrogation is necessary to find out the origin of contraband.

In view of this, no ground for anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
