Though, instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take necessary action against official respondent No.4 for not recording the true version of complainant/petitioner against respondents No. 5 to 7 while registering FIR No. 98, dated 26.06.2015, under Sections 306 and 34 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, Sangrur but learned counsel for petitioner feels satisfied, in case, representation dated 13.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) moved by petitioner got inquired into and disposed of.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in his representation dated 13.07.2015 (Annexure P-2) and, in case, some substance is found, to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
