In this petition under section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought a direction to respondent No.2 for registering an FIR against respondent No.3. According to learned counsel, respondent No.3 made a wrong statement before the Tehsildar and the Sub Divisional Magistrate and needs to be booked under the relevant provisions of IPC.

Admittedly, petitioner has already filed a civil suit regarding the agreement to sell dated 29.4.2011. I do not find any case for issuance of a direction to register the FIR. Petitioner can pursue appropriate remedy available under the law.

Dismissed.
