FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner-Amrik Singh in this anticipatory bail application are that he while being Lambardar of village Faru Wala identified and attested the family tree of deceased Heera Singh resident of village Chak Rao Ke and on the basis of which mutation has been sanctioned in the name of Makhan Singh being the lone heir which was contrary to the actual state of affairs. The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has denied his signatures on the attestation and that he has no role to play in the commission of offence are vehemently opposed on behalf of the State and it is contended that the petitioner had made subsequent statement before the police admitting his signatures on the same.

Appreciating these submissions, the role attributed to the petitioner, seriousness of the allegations and

keeping in view the fact that being a Revenue officer petitioner is supposed to remain credible and trustworthy but he has belied the duties attached to his office, therefore, does not deserves concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
