Petitioner's marriage was solemnized on 18.12.1996 and four children took birth from this wedlock. Allegations are of moral character of respondent No.5 who as per claim of petitioner is involved in nefarious activities with some bad elements. Precisely in that context representations of petitioner dated 08.05.2015 and 19.06.2015 (Annexures P-1 and P-3) are statedly pending before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ripu Daman, A.A.G., Haryana

accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass no specific reply is needed.

At this stage, respondent No.2 is directed to have fair look on the grievance of petitioner and may pass appropriate order on the representations (Annexures P-1 and P-3) submitted by petitioner before him by passing speaking order and if necessary petitioner may also be given audience.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
