It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that while arriving at a conclusion that the applications filed by the petitioner were false, SHO Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur did not join the petitioner and did not even record her statement. It is submitted that it would suffice if the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur looks into the representation (Annexure P.2) made by the petitioner.

It is further submitted that after the alleged compromise, the petitioner was being harassed.

On the other hand, it is submitted by counsel for respondents No.4 to 6 that petitioner has a dispute regarding partition of property with her family members and is moving false applications before the police.

However, respondents No.4 to 6 should have no objection if the Senior Superintendent of Police dispose of the representation moved by the petitioner after looking into the matter.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to dispose of the representation dated 30.6.2014 (Annexure P.2) within 45 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
