The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Baljit Kaur seeking directions to respondent No.3 to comply with provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C. while calling petitioner as well as her family members to police station on false and frivolous complaint preferred by respondent No.4 against Parkash Masih, as respondent No.3 is unnecessarily calling petitioner to police station while threatening her and other family members to rope in a false and frivolous case.

Notice to respondents No.1 to 3, only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ankur Jain, A.A.G., Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Copy of the

petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P-1).

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Batala to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in her representation dated 15.07.2015 (Annexure P-1) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
