Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner/husband-Rakesh Kumar in case FIR No.69 dated 09.05.2014 for offence punishable under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

The wife of the petitioner died because of burns suffered by putting petrol on her person and alighting herself, it appears that extreme steps was taken on the refusal of her parents to return the money. The allegations against the petitioner is that he was carrying a bottle full of petrol ultimately used by the wife.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Jagan Nath states that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has

joined the investigation and nothing more is to be recovered.

In view of the above, interim protection/bail granted vide order dated 13.08.2015 is made absolute.

Nothing expressed herein above shall be construed as an opinion on the merits of the case.

Petition stands disposed of.
