The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.149 dated 09.04.2015 registered under Sections 15, 29-61-85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, Distt. Kurukshetra.

The petitioner was found in possession of 9 kgs. 100 grams of poppy husk. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2015 and since charges have already been framed he ought to be released on bail considering the small recovery that has been effected from him.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer. However, it is stated that no other case of the like nature is pending against the petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and noticing the period of custody of the petitioner and also the non-pendency of any other case of the like nature, instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be enlarged on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.PC subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kurukshetra.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression
on the merits of the case.
