Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.219, dated 05.09.2013, under Sections 436/427/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

During the course of arguments today, counsel for the petitioner has very fairly conceded that the petitioner already stands declared proclaimed offender. Counsel accordingly prays for withdrawal of the present petition and makes a further submission that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender and if thereafter an application seeking benefit of regular bail is filed, directions be issued to the competent Court to decide such application within a stipulated time frame.

As per submission made by counsel, present petition seeking concession of pre-arrest bail is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is further observed that in case the petitioner duly surrenders within a period of one week from today and thereafter files an application seeking regular bail, the competent Court would make every endeavor to

expedite the hearing and disposal of the same.
