This petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.47 dated 26.03.2014, registered under Sections 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial in nature. The petitioner is in custody since 26.03.2014 and the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future. The petitioner is not involved in any other FIR.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel submits that the charge stands framed against the accused-petitioner and out of eight prosecution witnesses, none has been examined so far.

Heard.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances and the fact that the petitioner has already suffered the incarceration since 26.03.2014 and also the fact that he is not involved in any other case, it would be just and expedient to order the release of the petitioner on bail. This petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
