

Ditta Ram Vs. Ram Pal alias Pahari and ors.

(Appeal against the Award dated 11.9.2000 passed by Shri Dharam Pal, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Karnal, in Claim Petition No.122 of 1999)

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹30,000/- (₹ Thirty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim, subject to all just exceptions and checking of cross appeal. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant – Ditta Ram, by way of cheque, to be delivered to learned counsel for the appellant by learned counsel/representative of the Insurance Company on 18.11.2015, otherwise, two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount before the MACT, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. Appellant may furnish bank account particulars with IFS Code to the Insurance Company/MACT.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
