Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of two accused persons, namely Sukhsimran Singh @ Azad and his father-Harpal Singh @ Bhalla (petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 respectively herein) in case FIR No. 75, dated 28.05.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) for offences punishable under Sections 365/342/394/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station 'B' Division, District Amritsar.

Due to a case of road rage, the petitioners/accused are alleged to have given beatings to the complainant-Vikas Jain (respondent No. 2 herein) and taken away his car, mobile, gold chain and watch etc. The petitioners were taken in custody on 28.05.2015.

The prayer for bail on account of compromise effected between the parties.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, states that on completion of investigation, challan stands presented. He further points out that the petitioners, after granting interim bail by this Court in the present petition, have also filed a separate petition for quashing the aforesaid FIR on the basis of compromise.

In the light of statements of the parties having been got recorded before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar, on 08.09.2015, the factum of compromise is not contested by the prosecution.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also undertakes to deposit costs as determined by this Court.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioners by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2015, is confirmed, subject to payment of costs as determined by this Court in the prayer for quashing the FIR case bearing No. CRM-M No. 25160 of 2015 of even date.
