The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to register a case against respondents No. 4 to 9 for committing cheating and solemnized the second marriage by respondent No.4 without getting divorce from his first wife, who is daughter of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) be directed to decide complaint Annexure P-4 given by the petitioner.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to look into the complaint (Annexure P-4) and decide the same at the earliest.
