Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 13.5.2015 under Sections 307, 324, 34, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Tibber, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 13.5.2015 and as per the contents of the FIR, no injury has been attributed to the petitioner, rather the injuries have been attributed to Deepak (who is son of the petitioner)

and Bhushan. The dispute was regarding some transaction in an agreement to sell. He further submits that for the last three dates, the prosecution has not come forward to lead its evidence, for which, the petitioner is suffering.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioner is the conspirator, as it is at her behest, the incident has taken place.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, submits that the injuries caused are serious in nature, as one of the fingers of the complainant has been chopped off.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 13.5.2015 and the trial is at the initial stage which will take sufficient long time, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner deserves the benefit of bail. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
