Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Constable Dalip Singh No.27997, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 420/120-B of Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No. 351, dated 10.12.2014, registered at Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga, very fairly conceded that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court on 05.02.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required in the present case.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions dated 05.02.2015 passed by this Court, are made absolute.

Petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the condition as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
