The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 45 dated 22.05.2014 registered at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the charge has not been framed yet and the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2014.

Learned State counsel submits that co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail and three of them have filed application seeking their discharge.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
