Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in a case arising out of FIR No. 108, dated 18.09.2014, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Darbara Singh, apprises the Court that the investigation in this case is pending.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been behind bars since 26.06.2015. The learned counsel further contends that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioners can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
